Main Motions. These motions are listed in order of precedence. A motion can be introduced if it is higher on the chart than the pending motion.

Parliamentary law question	Parliamentary inquiry	None	You clarify a factual error (no discussion)
Request for information	Point of information	None	Chair clarifies procedure

Incidental Motions. These motions are decided immediately.

Amend a motion	Amendment is "in the same spirit" as the motion		Originator of the motion accepts or rejects
End discussion that is not bringing up new points	Several discussion points express opinions that have already been stated		Chair may limit or end discussion on a motion
