Parli-Pro Question/Discussion Structure:

Voting by Placard

- Vote in the interest of your residential council
- When the phrase called out that you agree with, hold up placard:
 - **"In favor"**: You agree with the motion
 - **"Opposed"**: You disagree with the motion
 - **"Abstain"**: You have an ethical dilemma that you cannot overcome
 - Common Example: If you are in a romantic relationship with that person presenting the information
 - Will take away your entire council's vote
- Need ²/₃ majority for a successful vote

 - Common Example: If you are in a romantic relationship with that person presenting the information
 - Will take away your entire council's vote
- Ballots will be counted by President and Advisor in a separate space
 - Need $\frac{2}{3}$ majority for a successful vote
